APPENDIX

2. Special provisions

2.5

To avoid soil pollution, participants/competitors must put a water-repellent and hydrocarbon-resistant plastic sheet (mat, cover) under their competition car. Such sheets must be brought by participants/competitors themselves.

2.6

Waste water, eg from motorhomes, must be disposed of at the appropriate facilities available. Disposing of the fluids at other places is strictly forbidden.

2.7

The legal principle of avoiding waste applies. The waste must be separated according to the containers provided. For residual waste, all participants are handed out a waste bag at administrative checking.

2.8

It is forbidden to mark the posts along the race track with paint. Those posts are part of public traffic and are the property of the Osnabrück District authorities. The posts will be removed before practice anyway.

Any Driver/Competitor who violates the provisions of No.1 or No. 2 of the Appendix can be disqualified by the stewards or be penalised otherwise.

Information for all participants and team members:

In the gymnasium near the paddock area by the Borgloh school and sports centre, showers and washing facilities will be available all weekend.
